

SHERRILL Bedroom by Design FAQs

Q: Is Color Match available on this program?

A: Yes, following the normal -CM upcharge for Sherrill Occasional. Also, selecting color match or any finish outside of the program means the order will ship on normal casegoods timing and not the 4 to 6 weeks target for this program.

Q: Which finishes are most consistent or show the most variation in the furniture?

A: The maple solids and walnut veneers used on this product are natural materials that absorb finish differently from one piece of wood to the next. We add a very light rock distressing by hand to minimize natural wood imperfections from standing out.

Natural Walnut (NT) and Cashew (C4) are our least concealing finishes and highlight the unique character of each piece of wood on the furniture. These are clear finishes that bring out the differences in color and grain pattern of each piece of wood on the furniture.

Greystone (G4), Cotswold (G1), Modern Elm (A2) and Ore (G3) are medium to darker finishes that showcase the wood character and use their own color base to balance out the natural color variation in the wood. The medium stains allow the natural wood character to show through, while the darker finishes create more consistency.

Mushroom (M1), Sandstone (P6) and Steel (G2) use a paint base, light brushing and color hangup to accent the texture of the woods. These finishes create a high level of finish consistency from piece to piece and mask the natural colors of the wood, while allowing the grain and texture to show through.

Cotton (WP), Sky (BP), Navy (NP), Sage (GP) and Coal (CP) are painted finishes that create the most consistency and conceal the natural colors of the wood, while allowing the grain and texture to show through.

Q: Can I use any fabric or leather on the Upholstered headboard?

A: Revolution fabrics and Runner Leathers are graded in at program pricing and will ship in the 4-to-6-week timeframe. Yes, you can select any other fabrics to use at the published grade jumps, plus any other applicable upcharges per the price list (fabric transfer fees, COM upcharge, etc). Note, selecting non-program fabric or upholstery moves the order out of the program lead time and into normal casegoods shipping schedule.

Q: Will this bed work with an adjustable base?

A: Yes, the inside of the bed is +2" larger all the way around than an adjustable base of the equivalent bed size. You may use the adjustable base with it's legs attached or you may remove the adjustable base legs and place it directly onto the support slats.

Q: What is the support system for the bed?

A: The support system consists of wood supports attached to each of the side rails and notched to accept 5 cross slats made of 2 ¾" solid wood, much thicker than typical wooden slat support design.

Q: Will this bed work with a bunkie board?

A: Yes, a bunkie board may be placed directly on the support slats. The inside rail height measured from the top of a typical bunkie board is around 6". Check your mattress height and edge support to select a mattress that is several inches taller than the inside rail height. NOTE: Plush or Pillow Top mattresses, and All Foam mattresses will need to be much taller than Firm mattresses for comfortable use when sitting on edge of the bed.

Q: What type of drawer glides are used?

A: The drawer glides are bottom mounted, adjustable, soft close drawer mechanisms.

Q: What type of wood is the furniture made of?

A: The bed and furniture are made with maple solids and quartered walnut veneers.

Q: Does the furniture meet tip-test safety requirements?

A: Yes, all bedroom furniture in the group meets the federally mandated anti-tipping safety standards.

Q: Do the Headboard Only styles come pre-drilled for bolting on a bed frame?

A: Yes, the 4 pre-drilled holes located just inside of the headboard post (see photo below) are positioned to work with common standard bed frame brackets.
